Boose, III, Agent, for the REZONING FROM AR-AGRICULTURAL RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO RTS-RESIDENTIAL TRANSITIONAL SUBBURBAN DISTRICT on a parcel of land in Sections 25 and 36, Township 42 South, Range 41 East, being more particularly described as follows:

Section 25 less the East 200 feet thereof and Section 36 less the East 200 feet and the South 330 feet thereof. Said property located on the west side of State Road No. 7 (U.S. 441), approximately 1 mile south of Northlake Boulevard was approved as advertised.
