## RESOLUTION NO. R - 85 - 37

## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION 84-117, Rezoning

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No.  $73\pm2$  have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No.  $84 \pm 117$  was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on the  $24 \, \text{th}$  of August 1984; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner agreed that the development shall retain on-site 85% of the stormwater runoff generated **by** a three (3) year storm per requirements of the Permit Section, Land Development Division; and

WHEREAS, the petitioner agreed that he shall receive approval for all construction plans from the five control districts prior to applying for a building permit; and WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. The proposal is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this the 24th of August 1984, that Petition No. 84-117 the petition of HARRELL AND REBECCA CHAMPION fox the REZONING, FROM CN-NEIGHBORHOOD COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT on Lots 52, 53, 54 and 55, Block 28, West Gate Estates (Northern Section) in Section 30, Township 43 South, Range 43 East, as recorded

in Plat Book 8, Page 38. Said property located on the north side of West Gate Avenue, approximately 300 feet west of Osceola Drive was approved subject to voluntarily committments.
