- 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby reaffirmed and ratified.
- 2. The following described right of way le hereby abandoned and closed as public right of way,' and this Board does hereby renounce and disclaim any right or interest of Palm Beach County and the public in and to the following:

Beginning at the Northwest corner of Lot 28, Block 1, Atlantic Park, recorded in Plat Book 14, Page 1, Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida: thence Southerly along the Easterly right of way of Second Street, a distance of S97.36 feet, more or less, to the North right of way line of Forest Avenue, thence Westerly, a distance of 30.0 feet thence Northerly along the Westerly right of way of Second Street, a distance of 597.46 feet

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to the Northeast corner of Block 2, said Atlantic Park; thence Easterly distance of 30.0 feet to the Point of Beginning.

3. Notice of the adoption of this Resolution shall be published once In the Palm Beach Post Times within thirty (30) days of the date of adoption of this Resolution in accordance with Section 336.10, Florida Statutes and Ordinance No. 71-3.



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
