RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION 85-9, Rezoning

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this the 24th of January 1985, that Petition No. 85-9 the petition of THEODORE BABBIT, TRUSTEE By Paul Thompson, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM RH-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (HIGH DENSITY) TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT on a parcel of land lying in the Southwest 1/4 of Section 3, Township 41 South, Range 42 East, being more particularly described as follows:

That part of the West 160.00 feet of the North 480.00 feet of the West 1/2 of the West 1/4 of the East 1/2 of the Southwest 1/4 of said Section 3 lying Northerly of a line 400.00 feet South of (as measured at right angles to) the South right-of-way line of State Road No. 706 (a 120.00 foot right-of-way). Less however that part of said West 160.00 feet lying Northerly of a line 70.00 feet South of (as measured at right angles to) the centerline of the aforesaid State

Road No. 706. Said property located on the south side of Indiantown Road (S.R. 706) approximately .2 mile west of Central Boulevard was approved as advertised.
