## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION 85-60, Rezoning

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this the 27th of June 1985, that Petition No. 85-60 the petition of WILSHIRE CORPORATION, By Stanley Franks, President for the REZONING, FROM RM-RESIDENTIAL MULTIPLE FAMILY DISTRICT (MEDIUM DENSITY) TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT on Lots C and D, Block 32, Palm Beach Farms Company Plat No. 7, in Section 30, Township 44 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 5, Page 72. Said property located on the west side of Congress Avenue (S.R. 807) approximately .2 mile south of Lake Worth Road (S.R. 802) was approved as advertised.


