## RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION 85-133, Special Exception

David Kelley, Jr., Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A CHURCH, INCLUDING ACCESSORY BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES on the South 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 11, Township 43 South, Range 41 East. Said property located on the northwest corner of the intersection of Royal Palm Beach Boulevard and 42nd Road North in an AR-Agricultural Residential District was denied with prejudice as advertised.
