RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION OF FLORIDA REINVESTMENT,
PETITION NO. 83-104(B)

WHEREAS, Florida Reinvestment, petitioned the Palm Beach County Planning Commission and the Board of County Commissioners, sitting as the final zoning authority, on August 1, 1985 and August 22, 1985, respectively, for the modificatin of Commission Requirements on property located on the east side of Military Trail (S.R. 809), approximately .7 mile north of Okeechobee Boulevard (S.R. 704): and

on the east side **of** Military Trail approximately 150 feet south of Woodstock Drive and approximately .7 mile north **of** Okeechobee Boulevard (S.R. 704).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.
- 2. The property location of Resolution No. R-85-1876D is amended.
