RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF
PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE RECORDING
OF A NOTICE RELATING TO THE APPROVAL OF SEPTIC TANK
PERMITS WITHIN THE M1 AND M2 ACREAGE AREAS OF THE
INDIAN TRAIL WATER CONTROL DISTRICT

WHEREAS, certain areas of the M1 and M2 acreage areas of the
Indian Trail Water Control District have not been approved for the
issuance of septic tank permits by the County Health Department; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners have been made aware
that many owners of property within certain areas of the M1 and M2
acreage have purchased property on the understanding that such property
may be developed for residential purposes, and

WHEREAS, many such owners have later been advised by the County
Health Department that the issuance of septic tank permits for their
property has not been approved due to incomplete and inadequate drainage,
thereby prohibiting further development in accordance with the desires of
the owners of such property, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest and welfare of prospective
purchasers that they be placed on notice of potential restrictions on the
use of their property regarding development as such development is
restricted by the inability to obtain a septic tank permit, and

WHEREAS, the legal descriptions contained in the maps
attached hereto have been reviewed and approved by the County Health
Department.

Now, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the foregoing notice
relating to the approval of septic tank permits is approved and is to be
recorded, along with the Resolution, in the Public Records of Palm Beach
County, Florida.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner Adams
who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Wilson

NOTICE RELATING TO THE APPROVAL OF SEPTIC TANK PERMITS

THE FOLLOWING IS INTENDED TO PLACE PURCHASER'S ON NOTICE AS TO THE POSITION OF CERTAIN REGULATORY AGENCIES AS TO THE APPROVAL OF PERMITS FOR SEPTIC TANKS WITHIN THE FOLLOWING DESCRIBED AREAS LOCATED IN PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA.

Township 43 South, Range 40 East, all of Sections 10 and 11; that portion of Section 13 lying to the west of Indian Trail Water Control District's M-2 canal, and all of Sections 14 and 15, commonly known as the "Indian Trail Water Control District M-2 acreage Area."

AND

Township 42 South, Range 40 East. The south one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of Sections 13, 14 and 15; and all Sections of 23, 24, 25, 26, 27 and 28.

Township 42 South, Range 41 East. The West one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 17; all of Sections 18 and 19; all of Section 20 less the northwest one-quarter ($\text{NW } \frac{1}{4}$) of the northeast one-quarter ($\text{NE } \frac{1}{4}$) thereof; all of Sections 21, 22, 27, 28, 29, 30 and 31; the west one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) and the west one-third ($\frac{1}{3}$) of the east one-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of Section 32, and all of Sections 33, 34 and 35.

The Indian Trail Water Control District is a special taxing district created for the purpose of draining the land that is within its jurisdiction as well as providing roadways within its boundaries. As of November, 1985, there are certain areas of the Indian Trail Water Control District that are open for development. Other areas are not yet developable. The Palm Beach County Health Department is the local agency responsible for the issuance of septic tank permits for the M-1 and M-2 acreage areas. The Health Department, relies primarily on the South Florida Water Management District for the determination as to whether a given area is adequately drained. As of November 1985, the only portions of the above-described M-1 and M-2 acreage areas that may be approved by the Palm Beach County Health Department for the issuance of septic tank permits are the following:

M-1 Acreage Area - (Sections 33, 34 and 35, Township 42 South, Range 41 East); Sections 2, 3, 4, 9, 10 and 11, Township 43 North, Range 41 East.

M-2 Acreage Area - (Sections 13, less the part that lies to the west of the M-2 canal, Sections 24 and 25, Township 43 South, Range 40 East).
