RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION 84-102(C), Special Exception

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

BRYAN, 111, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO AMEND THE SITE PLAN FOR A COMMERCIAL NEW AND USED AUTOMOBILE VEHICLE SALE, RENTAL AND REPAIR FACILITIES AND LOT, PREVIOUSLY APPROVED UNDER ZONING PETITION NO. 84-102(B) on the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 1, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, LESS the East 53 feet for road purposes. Said property located on the southwest corner of the intersection of Military Trail (S.R. 809) and Sunny Lane in an CG-General Commercial District was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The petitioner shall present a notarized Affidavit of Disclosure at the Zoning Authority meeting.
