

RESOLUTION NO. R-86-468

RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION 85-118(A), Rezoning

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 85-118(A) was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on the 30th December 1985; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. This proposal is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this the 30th of December 1985, that Petition No. 85-118(A) the petition of D.J. SNAPP, III, for the REZONING, FROM RS-RESIDENTIAL SINGLE FAMILY DISTRICT TO CS-SPECIALIZED COMMERCIAL DISTRICT on Lot 5 and 6, Drew Manor, in Section 18, Township 44 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 21, Page 36, Less the East 17 feet thereof. Said property located on the west side of Congress Avenue (S.R. 807) approximately 0.7 mile south of Forest Hill boulevard (S.R. 882), and being bounded on the South by L.W.D.D. Lateral Canal No. 9 was approved as advertised.

Commissioner Spillias, moved for approval of the petition. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Owens, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

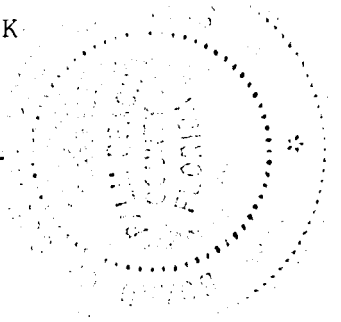
