Carpenter, Agent, for the REZONING, FROM AR-AGRICULTURAL RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMPRCIAL DISTRICT on a parcel of land lying in Section 22, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, being more particularly described as follows:
