RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION 85-159(A), Special Exception

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this the 27th of March 1986, that Petition No. 85-159(A) the petition of ARTHUR AND BARBARA ROSACKER, MILDRED ROSACKER, WILLIAM ROBINSON AND WILLIAM TINNERMAN, By David Carpenter, Agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW AN ENCLOSED STORAGE FACILITY, INCLUDING A WHOLESALE NURSERY on a parcel of land lying in Section 22, Township 46 South, Range 42 East, being more particularly described as follows:

The Northwest 1/4 of Northeast 1/4, of the Northeast 1/4, subject to State and County and Lake Worth Drainage District taxes subsequent to the 1944 levies.

Excepting therefrom a strip of land forty (40) feet in width on each side of the Center Line of the County Road.

Subject to right-of-way for Delray West Road. Said property located on the south side of Delray West Road (S.R. 806), approximately .2 mile east of Carter Road was denied with prejudice as advertised.
