CONDITION NO. 12 STATES:

- "12. The facility shall close at 11:00 P.M. each evening."
 REQUEST: TO MODIFY CONDITION NO. 12 TO READ:
- "12. The facility shall close at 11:00 P.M. each evening except Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays when it shall close at 2:00 A.M. the following morning."

Said property located on the west side of Military Trail (S.R. 809), approximately .2 mile north of Hypoluxo Road in a CG-General

Commercial District was denied with prejudice as advertised.
