

RESOLUTION NO. R-86-865

RESOLUTION DENYING ZONING PETITION 86-41, Special Exception

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 86-41 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at its public hearing conducted on the 5th May 1986; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. This proposal is not consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this the 5th of May 1986, that Petition No. 86-41 the petition of JOSEPH TATUM AND P & J BECK, INC., By Alan Ciklin, Esquire, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW GASOLINE PUMP ISLAND FACILITIES on Lots 17, 18, and 19, Cinquez Park, in Section 3, Township 41 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 20, Page 81. Said property located on the northwest corner of the intersection of Indiantown Road (S.R. 706) and Palm Road, being bounded on the north by Palmetto Street was denied with prejudice as advertised.

Commissioner Spillias, moved for denial of the petition. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Wilken, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

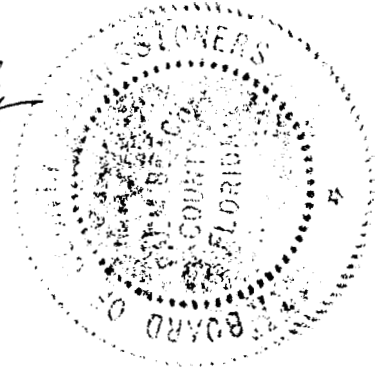
