CONDITION NO. & STATES:

6. "There shall be no on-site kitchen facilities.

REQUEST: TO DELETE CONDITION NO. 6

Said property located on the east side of A.1.A. (S.R. 703). being bounded on the north by Turtle Beach Road and on the east by Lake Worth in an RS-Residential Single Family District was approved as advertised subject to the following condition:

- 1. Condition No. 6 of Resolution No. R-81-1628 which states:
 - "6. There shall be no on-site kitchen facilities" is hereby deleted.
- Petitioner shall provide adequate utility service for kitchen facilities.
