## RESOLUTION NO. R-87-105

RESOLUTION FIPPROVING ZONING PETITIDN 86-55, Special Exception

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREFIS, Petition No. 86-55 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, sitting as the Zoning Authority, at its public hearing conducted on July 24, 1986 and

WHEREFIS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. With required site plan modification, this proposal will be consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and Zoning Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOFIRD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PHILM BEFICH COUNTY, FLORIDA, assembled in regular session this 27th day of January, 19\_87, that: Petition No. 86-55, the petition of JULIUS L. WHSKOW AND MILENNIUM, INC., By Kieran J. Kilday, Agent, for the SPECIFIL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW A PLFINNED COMMERCIFIL DEVELOPMENT on Lots 1 through 6, inclusive, Block 4, Palm Acres Estates, in Section 5, Township 44 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 20, Page 5. Said property located on the southeast corner of the intersection of Alabama Street and Congress Avenue (S.R. 807) and being bounded on the

south by L.W. D. D. Canal No. L-5 was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Prior to site plan certification, the site plan shall be amended to reflect the following:
  - a) required landscape strips
  - b) interior landscaping calculations
  - c) tree requirement in tabular
- 2. The development shall retain onsite 85% of the stormwater runoff generated by a three (3) year-one hour storm per requirements of the Permit Section, Land Development Division. The drainage system shall be maintained in an acceptable condition per the County Engineers approval.
- 3. A complete septic tank application shall be approved by the Palm Beach County Health Department prior to site plan approval.
