CONDITION NO. 15 STATES:

15. The sewer and water lines for this project shall be extended to this site along Kelmar Drive.

REQUEST TO AMEND CONDITION NO. 15 TO READ:

The water lines for this project shall be extended to the site along Kelmar Drive.

Said property located on the east side of Haverhill Road, approximately 3 mile south of Summit Boulevard in a RM-Residential Multiple Family District (Medium Density) was approved as advertised subject to the following conditions:

- 1. The developer shall comply with all previous conditions of approval unless expressly modified herein.
- The proposed extension of utility lines along Haverhill Road shall be coordinated with the construction of Haverhill Road to prevent any open cutting of the road after the construction of Haverhill Road from Forest Hill Boulevard to Summit Boulevard has been completed.
