Weyant, Agent, for a REZONING, FROM CS-SPECIALIZED COMMERCIAL DISTRICT TO CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL DISTRICT WITH A CONCURRENT SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO ALLOW OFFICE/WAREHOUSE COMBINATIONS on the East 210 feet of Tract 72, in Section 19, Township 44 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 6, Page 66; LESS the South 351.76 feet

therefrom and LESS the North 15 feet conveyed to the County of Palm Beach for 2nd Avenue North Right-of-way as shown in Official Record Book 3540 at Page 1005.
