WHERERS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoming Code Ordinance Nu. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 84-77(A) was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, sitting as the Zoming Authority, at its public hearing conducted on January 5, 1987; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the ${f Board}$ of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. This proposal is not consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and local land development regulations.

NOW. THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA that: Petition No. 84-77(A), the petition of GREEN TURTLE ASSOCIATES By John L. Trusler, Agent, for a REZONING, FROM CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL ZONING DISTRICT, IN PQRT, RND RH-MULTIPLE FQMILY RESIDENTIAL ZONING DISTRICT (HIGH DENSITY), IN PRRT, ENTIRELY TU CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL ZONING DISTRICT commercing at a point 160 feet West of the Northeast corner of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 3, Township 41 South, Range 42 East; thence West 100 feet; thence South 544.50

feet; thence East 100 feet; thence North 541.50 feet to the Point of Beginning. Less and excepting a square tract or parcel of land 108 feet on each side, lying and being in the Southwest corner of that tract or parcel of land.
