WHEREFIS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHERERS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

Kilday, Agent, for a rezoning from RH-RESIDENTIRL MULTIPLE FFIMILY (HIGH DENSITY) ZONING DISTRICT TO CG-GENERFIL COMMERCIFIL ZONING DISTRICT WITH A CONCURRENT SPECIAL EXCEPTION TO RLLOW COMMERCIFIL NEW FIND USED, FIUTOMOBILE, TRUCK, BOAT, MOTORCYCLE, MOBILE HOME, RECREFITIONFIL VEHICLE SFILE FIND RENTRL REPFIIR FRCILITY FIND LOT on Lot

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66, Morrison Homes, in Section 5, Township 44 South, Range 43 East, as recorded in Plat Book 23, page 190.
