RESOLUTION WITHDRAWING ZONING PETITION \$86-28

Marcus, Chairman, for a rezoning from CG-General Commercial Zoning District to RH-Multiple Fanily Residential Zoning District on Lots 1 through 16 and Lots 43 through 46, Block 25, West Gate Estates, in Section 30, Township 43 South, Range 43 East as recorded in Plat Book 8, Page 38, located on property on the north side of Westgate Avenue and on the south side of Cherokee Avenue, approximately 350 feet west of Wabasso Avenue, was withdrawn, without prejudice.
