RESOLUTION WITHDRAWING ZONING PETITION \$86-40

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No, 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Canmissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. This proposal is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and local land development regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA that: Petition No. \$86-40 (regarding Zoning Petition No. 82-152(A), Resolution No. R-83-204), the petition of the Board of County Commissioners, by Karen T. Marcus, Chairman, to revoke the Special Exception for an Office/Warehouse combination, including a Recreational Vehicle Storage Facility located as mapped on Palm Beach County Zoning Quad Sheet Number 31, on the east side of Military Trail (S.R. 809), approximately 0.3 of a mile north of Okeechobee Road (S.R. 704), was withdrawn, without prejudice.
