RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION NO. 73-96(A) MODIFICATION OF COMMISSION REQUIREMENTS PETITION OF HENRY G. AND MARY DEBLOUW

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code Ordinance No. 73-2 have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 73-96(A) was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, sitting as the Zoning Authority, at its public hearing conducted on September 30, 1987; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, this approval is subject to Zoning Code Section 402.9 (Mandatory Review of Development Approvals) and other provisions requiring that development commence in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

1. This proposal is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive and local land development regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF FALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA that Petition No. 73-96(A), the petition of HENRY G. AND MARY DEBLOUW, for a MODIFICATION OF COMMISSION REQUIREMENTS, on a parcel of land lying on the West 200 feet of the North 1/2 of the North 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 13, Township 44 South, Range 42 East; less the Right-of-Way for Military Trail and also less the North 50 feet of canal and road Right-of-Way, located on the east side of Military Trail (S.R. 809), and bounded on the north by the Lake Worth Drainage District Lateral Canal No. 8, in a CG-General Commercial Zoning District, was approved as advertised, subject to the following conditions:

1. The developer shall comply with all previous conditions

of approval unless expressly modified herein.

- 2. Condition No. 1 of Resolution R-73-448, which presently states:
 - "1. The South turnout to be temporary only." is hereby deleted.
- 3. This property owner shall convey an additional 10 feet for a total of 20 feet for access to the public along the project's north property line prior to December 1, 1987.
