Kilday, Agent, for a REZONING FROM AR-AGRICULTURAL RESIDENTIAL ZONING DISTRICT TO RS-SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL ZONING DISTRICT, on a parcel of land lying on the West 1/2 of Tract 7, Block 5, PALM BEACH FARMS COMPANY PLAT NO. 3, in Section 34, Township 43 South, Range 42 East, as recorded in Plat Book 2, Pages 45 -54, inclusive; SUBJECT TO easements reservations, restrictions and rights-of-way of record, located on the south side of Belvedere Road, (Tenth Street North), approximately .3 mile west of 65th Avenue North, was approved as advertised.
