RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION NO. 88-115 REZONING PETITION OF MAS VERDE MOBILE HOME ESTATE, INC.

1. This proposal is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and local land development regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Petition No. 88-115, the petition of MAS VERDE MOBILE HOME ESTATE, INC., Marda L. Zimring, Agent, for a REZONING FROM AR-AGRICULTURAL RESIDENTIAL ZONING DISTRICT, IN PART, AND CG-GENERAL COMMERCIAL ZONING DISTRICT, IN PART, ENTIRELY TO RS-SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENTIAL ZONING DISTRICT, on a parcel of land lying on the East 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 26, Township 44 South, Range 42 East.

Together with:

The East 1/2 of the West 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 and the East 3/4 of the North 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 26, Township 44 South, Range 42 East.

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Together with:

The South 70 feet of the North 90 feet of the East 3/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 26, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, less the Right-of-way of State Road 802 as now laid out and in use, being located on the south side of Lake Worth Road (SR 802), approximately 1.0 mile east of Jog Road was approved as advertised.
