## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION NO. 89-69 REZONING PETITION OF GRACE ROMA BY DENNIS P. KOEHLER, AGENT

WHEREAS, (the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body) pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 89-69 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, sitting as the Zoning Authority, at its public hearing conducted on October 26, 1989; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, sitting as the Zoning Authority, has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, 402.5 of the Zoning Code requires that the action of the Board of County Commissioners, sitting as the Zoning Authority, be adopted by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Petition No. 89-69, the petition of GRACE ROMA, BY DENNIS P. KOEHLER, AGENT, for a REZONING FROM AR-AGRICULTURAL RESIDENTIAL ZONING DISTRICT TO CS-SPECIALIZED COMMERCIAL ZONING DISTRICT, Lots 114 to 125, inclusive, and the East 21.7 feet, of Lot 126; except that part taken for Lantana Road and less the South 40.00 feet thereof, Lake Osborne Subdivision, Hiatus Tract 37, Township 44 1/2 South, Range 42 East, recorded in Plat Book 9, Pages 42 and 43, being located on the Southwest corner of the intersection of Lantana Road (SR 812) and Lawrence Road. It is bounded on the South by Lake Worth Drainage District Lateral Canal No. 16, was approved on October 26, 1989, as advertised.
