WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, systematic monitoring and review of approved zoning actions help implement the goals and objectives of the Comprehensive Plan.

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Section 402.6 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 402.6, Status Report CR S87-80/2 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, sitting as the Zoning Authority, at a public hearing conducted on July 30, 1992; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, sitting as the Zoning Authority, has reviewed Status Report CR 587-80/2 and considered testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties, and the recommendations of the various county review agencies; and

WHEREAS, Section 402.6 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code authorizes the Board of County Commissioners, sitting as the Zoning Authority, to revoke Special Exceptions; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, sitting as the Zoning Authority, made the following findings of fact:

- 1. This proposal is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and local land development regulations; and
- The property owner failed to comply with a condition of approval.

WHEREAS, Section 402.5 of the Zoning Code requires that the action of the Board of County Commissioners, sitting as the Zoning Authority, be adopted by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the recommendation of Status Report No. CR S87-80/2, to revoke the Special Exception previously granted by the approval of the petition of Alfredo and Barbara Valdes, Petition No. 87-80, which allowed a child day care center, on the North 80 feet of the South 330 feet of the East 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 of Section 2, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, less the West 115 feet thereof and less the East 40 feet for Road Right-of-way., being located on the west side of Haverhill Road approximately 175 feet south of Palm Beach Canal Road, in a

RM-Multiple Family Residential District (Medium Density) Zoning District, is approved.
