## RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION NO. 92-11 REZONING PETITION OF JERALD GOLDSTEIN

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements, as provided for in Chapter 402.5 of the Palm Beach County Zoning Code, have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, Petition No. 92-11 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County, sitting as the Zoning Authority, at its Public Hearing conducted on June 29, 1992; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, sitting as the Zoning Authority, has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties, and the recommendations of the various county review agencies and the recommendations of the Planning Commission; and

WHEREAS, this approval is subject to the Zoning Code, Section 402.9 (Mandatory Review of Development Approvals) and other provisions requiring that development commence in a timely manner; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, sitting as the Zoning Authority, made the following findings of fact:

1. This proposal is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and local land development regulations.

WHEREAS, Chapter 402.5 of the Zoning Code, requires that the action of the Board of County Commissioners, sitting as the Zoning Authority, be adopted by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Petition No. 92-11, the petition of JERALD GOLDSTEIN, TRUSTEE, BY ROBERT BASEHART, AGENT, for a REZONING FROM THE AGRICULTURAL RESIDENTIAL (AR) ZONING DISTRICT TO THE MULTIPLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL (MEDIUM DENSITY) ZONING DISTRICT on a parcel of land lying in Tracts 61 and 62, BOYNTOM GARDENS, Section 23, Township 45 South, Range 42 East, according to the Plat thereof recorded in Plat Book 6, Page 32 of the Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida, LESS right-of-way for State Road 804 as set out in Deed Book 957, Page 482, Public Records of Palm Beach County, Florida, and being located on the NE CORNER OF BOYNTON BEACH BLVD.
