RESOLUTION CORRECTING RESOLUTION NO. R-2003-0424 WHICH APPROVED RECOMMENDATION OF STATUS REPORT SR 86-114B FOR PETITION NO. 86-114(B)

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners on March 27, 2003, conducted a public hearing for Status Report SR 86-114B; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-2003-0424 adopted on March 27, 2003, inadvertently contained an error in a referenced resolution number; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the following is the corrected resolution:

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, systematic monitoring and review of approved zoning actions help implement the goals and objectives of the Comprehensive Plan.

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements **as** provided for in Section 5.8 of the Palm Beach County Land Development Code have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.8, Status Report SR 86-114B was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at a public hearing conducted on March 27,2003; and

WHEREAS. the Board of County Commissioners has reviewed Status Report SR 86-114B and considered testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties, and the recommendations of the various county review agencies; and

WHEREAS, Section 5.8 of the Palm Beach County Land Development Code authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to add or modify conditions of approval; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

- 1. The site plan for the special exception is not consistent with the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code because it has not been reviewed for consistency with "Architectural Guidelines," Section 6.6.E., of the Unified Land Development Code.
- 2. With the new condition of approval, the site plan will be consistent with the Unified Land Development Code.
- 3. The amendment of conditions of approval is consistent with the Palm Beach County Comprehensive Plan and with the Unified Land Development Code.

WHEREAS, Section 5.3 of the Palm Beach County Land Development Code requires that the action of the Board of County Commissioners be adopted by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the recommendation of Status Report No. SR 86-114B, to amend Conditions of Approval of Resolution No. R-97-255, the

Development Order Amendment of Summit Christian School, Petition No. 86-114(B), which amended the Special Exception that allowed a private educational institutional including a day care facility to 1) add land area; 2) add square footage (90,760); 3) add access (2), property being legally described in Exhibit "A", being located on the southeast corner of Haverhill Road and Summit Boulevard in the RM-Multiple Family Residential (Medium Density) Zoning District, is approved, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. All previously approved conditions of approval continue to apply unless expressly modified herein. (ONGOING)
- 2. Prior to the issuance of a building permit, the property owner shall submit an application to the Development Review Committee for review and certification that the project is in compliance with Section 6.6.E. of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code, "Architectural Guidelines." (BLDG PERMIT: MONITORING Zoning)
