RESOLUTION APPROVING RECOMMENDATION OF STATUS REPORT NO. SR 1983-056C TO AMEND CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION NO. R-91-1465 WHICH APPROVED THE SPECIAL EXCEPTION OF AMERICAN MORTGAGE INVESTMENT, INC. PETITION NO. 1983-056(C)

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, systematic monitoring and review of approved zoning actions help implement the goals and objectives of the Comprehensive Plan.

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Section 5.8 of the Palm Beach County Land Development Code have been satisfied; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.8, Status Report SR 1983-056C was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at a public hearing conducted on September 17, 2003; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has reviewed Status Report SR 1983-056C and considered testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties, and the recommendations of the various county review agencies; and

WHEREAS, Section 5.8 of the Palm Beach County Land Development Code authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to add or modify conditions of approval; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

- 1. The development order is not consistent with the Unified Land Development Code because it has not been reviewed for consistency with Section 6.6.E. "Architectural Guidelines" of the Unified Land Development Code.
- 2. With the new condition of approval requiring the project to be certified for compliance with Section 6.6.E. of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code, the project will be consistent with the Unified Land Development Code as to architectural guidelines.
- 3. The amendment of conditions of approval is consistent with the Palm Beach County Comprehensive Plan and with the Unified Land Development Code.

WHEREAS, Section 5.3 of the Palm Beach County Land Development Code requires that the action of the Board of County Commissioners be adopted by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the recommendation of Status Report No. SR 1983-056C, to amend Conditions of Approval of Resolution No. R-91-1465, the Special Exception of American Mortgage Investment, Inc., Petition No. 1983-056(C), which approved an amendment to the site plan for West Boca Hospital to increase the square footage, property being legally described in Exhibit "A", being located on the on the east side of State Rd. #7, 0.5 mile south of Glades Rd. in the CSH-Specialized High Commercial Zoning District and granted a Special Exception to amend the site plan for West Boca Hospital to increase the square footage Zoning District . is approved, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. All previously approved conditions of approval continue to apply unless expressly modified herein. (ONGOING)
- 2. Prior to the issuance of a building permit, the property owner shall submit an application to the Development Review Committee for review and certification that the project is in compliance with Section 6.6.E. of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code. "Architectural Guidelines." (BLDG PERMIT: MONITORING Zoning)
