WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapter 163 and Chapter 125, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions relating to zoning; and

WHEREAS, systematic monitoring and review of approved zoning actions help implement the goals and objectives of the Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the notice and hearing requirements as provided for in Section 5.8 of the Palm Beach County Land Development Code have been satisfied: and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5.8, status Report SR 91-15.2 was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Palm Beach County at a public hearing conducted on October 27, 1994; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has reviewed Status Report SR 91-15.2 and considered testimony presented by the applicant and other interested parties, and the recommendations of the various county review agencies; and

WHEREAS, Section 5.8 of the Palm Beach County Land Development Code authorizes the Board of County Commissioners to revoke Special Exceptions: and

- 1. This proposal is consistent with the requirements of the Comprehensive Plan and local land development regulations: and
- 2. The property owner requested the revocation of the Special Exception.

WHEREAS, Section 5.3 of the Land Development Code requires that the action of the Board of county Commissioners be adopted by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the recommendation of Status Report No. SR 91-15.2, to revoke the Special Exception previously granted by the approval of the petition of Elk's Club Lodge #1530, Petition No. 91-15, confirmed by the adoption of Resolution R-91-1079, for a recreation facility and club (Elk's Club), on a parcel of land lying West 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 of Section 24, Township 44 South, Range 42 East, being located on the south side of Bowman Street, approximately 350 feet west of Military

Trail, in the RM-Multiple Family Residential (Medium Density) 'Zoning District, is approved.
