RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION R-97-775
RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION OF OUR LADY QUEEN OF PEACE
PETITION CA94-87(A)

WHEREAS, Our Lady Queen of Peace, petitioned the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners on June 23, 1997 for Class A Conditional Use to allow a Church or place of worship ; and

WHEREAS, Resolution R-97-775, adopted on June 23, 1997 confirming the action of the Board of County Commissioners inadvertently contained an error in Condition C.2 of Exhibit C; and

WHEREAS, Condition C.2 of Exhibit C of Resolution R-97-775 currently reads:

- 2. Outdoor recreation areas and accessory structures shall be set back a minimum of fifty (50) from all residential property lines. (DRC: ZONING)

Is hereby amended to read:

- 2. Outdoor recreation areas and accessory structures shall be set back a minimum of fifty (50) feet from all residential property lines. (DRC: ZONING)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.
- 2. Condition C.2 of Exhibit C of Resolution R-97-775 is hereby amended.
