RESOLUTION CORRECTING RESOLUTION NO. R-97-2083  
RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION OF  
THE MORTON GROUP  
PETITION NO. PDD96-107(A)

WHEREAS, The Morton Group petitioned the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners on December 4, 1997 for an OFFICIAL ZONING MAP AMENDMENT (REZONING) from the Agricultural Residential (AR) Zoning District to the Residential Planned Unit Development (PUD) Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. R-97-2083 adopted December 4, 1997 confirming the action of the Board of County Commissioners, inadvertently contained an incorrect NOW THEREFORE clause; and

WHEREAS, the correct NOW THEREFORE of Resolution No. R-97-2083 should have read as shown below:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Zoning Petition PDD96-107(A), the petition of The Morton Group, by Robert Bentz, agent, for an OFFICIAL ZONING MAP AMENDMENT (REZONING) from the Agricultural Residential (AR) Zoning District to the Planned Unit Development (PUD) Zoning District on a parcel of land legally described in EXHIBIT A, attached hereto and made a part hereof, and generally located as indicated on a vicinity sketch attached as EXHIBIT B, attached hereto and made a part hereof, was approved on December 4, 1997.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.
2. The NOW THEREFORE of Resolution No. R-97-2083 is hereby amended.

The motion was seconded by Commissioner McCarty, and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

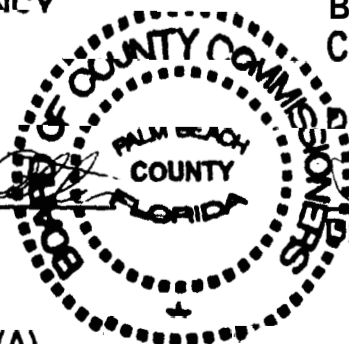
