WHEREAS, Julie Wiesner, petitioned the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners on April 23, 1998 for Conditional Use Class A (CA) to allow a Nursery, retail in the Agricultural Residential (AR) Zoning District; and

WHEREAS, Resolution R-98-569, adopted on April 23, 1998 confirming the action of the Board of County Commissioners inadvertently contained an error in Condition E.3.B of Exhibit C: and

WHEREAS, Condition E.3.B of Exhibit C of Resolution R-98-569 should have read as follows:

E.3.B. All required median landscaping, including an irrigation system if required, shall be installed at the property owners expense. All existing landscape material shall also be the perpetual maintenance obligation of the petitioner and its successors, heirs or assignees or duly established Property Owner's Association and/or Homeowners's Association. Perpetual maintenance includes, but is not limited to, pruning, fertilizing, irrigation, and alternate watering of Xeriscape material during periods of drought in order to maintain healthy plant material. All landscape material shall be installed prior to July 15, 1998 1999. (CO: MONITORING - Eng)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

- 1. The foregoing recitals are hereby affirmed and ratified.
- 2. Condition E.3.B of Exhibit C of Resolution R-98-569 is hereby amended.
