WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has considered the evidence and testimony presented by the petitioner and other interested parties, the recommendations of the various county review agencies, and the recommendation of the Zoning Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners made the following findings of fact:

- 1. This official zoning map amendment (rezoning) is consistent with the Palm Beach County Comprehensive Plan;
- 2. This official zoning map amendment (rezoning) is consistent with the requirements of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code;
- 3. This official zoning map amendment (rezoning) is compatible with surrounding uses and zones, as defined in the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code, is generally consistent with existing uses and zones surrounding the subject land, and is the appropriate zoning district for the land;
- 4. This official zoning map amendment (rezoning) does not result in significantly adverse impacts on the natural environment, including but not limited to water, air, stormwater management, wildlife, vegetation, wetlands, and the natural functioning of the environment;
- 5. This official zoning map amendment (rezoning) will result in a logical and orderly development pattern;
- 6. This official zoning map amendment (rezoning) complies with Article 11, (Adequate Public Facilities) of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code, Ordinance 92-20; and,
- 7. This official zoning map amendment (rezoning) is consistent with the requirements of all other applicable local land development regulations.



CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL

A. <u>ALL PETITIONS</u>

1. Development of the site is limited to the uses and site design as approved by the Board of County Commissioners. The approved master plan is dated August 31,1998. All modifications must be approved by the Board of County Commissioners unless the proposed changes are required to meet conditions of approval or are in accordance with the ULDC. (ONGOING: ZONING)

B. <u>BUILDING AND SITE DESIGN</u>

- 1. The maximum height for all structures, including all air conditioning and mechanical equipment, measured from finished grade to highest point, shall not exceed thirty (30) feet and two (2) stories. (BLDG PERMIT: BLDG Zoning)
- 2. Access to the Civic Pod from West Atlantic Avenue shall be deleted from the preliminary development plan and site or subdivision plan should the use of the pod be converted to residential. (ONGOING/PLAT: ZONING)
- 3. The proposed residential buildings shall be designed and constructed to be consistent with the facade elevations by Turner & Smith Architects and Planners dated October 22, 1998. (BLDG PERMIT: BLDG Zoning)

C. <u>ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES MANAGEMENT</u>

1. A 25% upland set-aside preserve shall be depicted on the Site plan and approved by Environmental Resources Management prior to DRC site plan certification. (DRC: ERM)

D. <u>LANDSCAPING - STANDARD</u>

- 1. All canopy trees required to be planted on site by this approval, except on individual residential lots, shall meet the following minimum standards at installation:
 - a. Tree height: Fourteen (14) feet.
 - b. Trunk diameter: 3.5 inches measured 4.5 feet above grade.
 - c. Canopy diameter: Seven (7) feet. Diameter shall be determined by the average canopy radius at 3 points measured from the trunk to the outermost branch tip. Each radius shall measure at least 3.5 feel in length.
 - d. Credit may be given for existing or relocated trees provided they **meet** current ULDC requirements. (CO: LANDSCAPE Zoning)
- 2. All palms required to be planted on site by this approval, shall be bootedSabal Palms and meet the following minimum standards at installation:

a.	Palm heights:	Twelve (12) feet clear trunk;
b.	Clusters:	Staggered heights twelve (12) to

- Clusters: Staggered heights twelve (12) to eighteen (18) feet; and
- c. Credit may be given for existing or relocated palms provided they me et current ULDC requirements. (CO: LANDSCAPE Zoning)

Petition PDD98-40 Project No. 0741-000 3. Agroup of three or more palmor pinetrees may supersede a maximum of 25% of the canopy trees in that location. (CO: LANDSCAPE - Zoning)

E. <u>ENGINEERING</u>

- 1. Prior to the issuance of a building permit the property owner shall convey to Palm Beach County Land Development Division by road right-of-way warrantydeed additional right of way for the construction of a right turn lan e on West Atlantic Avenue at the project's entrance road. This right-of-way shall be a minimum of 280 feet in storage length, twelve feet in width and a taper length of 50 feet or as approved by the County Engineer. This additional right of way shall be free of all encumbrances and encroachments and shall include "Corner Clips" where appropriate as determined by the County Engineer. Property owner shall provide Palm Beach County with sufficient documentation acceptable to the Right of Way Acquisition Section to ensure that the property is free of all encumbrances and encroachments. (BLDG PERI/IIT: MONITORING - Eng)
- 2. The Property owner shall construct a right turn lane west approach on West Atlantic Avenue at the projects entrance road.
 - a) This construction shall be concurrent with the paving and drainage improvements for the site. Any and all costs associated with the construction shall be paid by the property owner. These costs s hall include, but are not limited to, utility relocations and acquisition of any additional required right-of-way.
 - b) Permits required from FDOT for this construction shall be obtained prior to the issuance of the first Building Permit. (BLDG PERMIT: Monitor ng-Eng)
 - c) Construction shall be completed prior to the issuance of the first Certificate of Occupancy. (CO: MONITORING Eng)
- 3. LANDSCAPE WITHIN MEDIAN OF STATE ROADS
 - Prior to issuance of a building permit, the property owner shall app y to a. the Palm Beach County Engineering and Public Works Departmentfor a permit to landscape the adjacent median of West Atlantic Avenue Road Right-of-way. This permit, to be completed by the property owner. shall name Palm Beach Countyas the applicant. As part of this pe-mit process, the property ownershall enter into a Right of Way, Landscape Maintenance, Removal, and Indemnification Agreement. When landscaping is permitted by the Florida Department of Transportaton, landscaping shall, at a minimum, consist of the "Low Cost Planting Concept" outlined in the Palm Beach County Engineering and Public Works Department March 1994 Streetscape Standards. The property owner shall also be responsible to supplement any existing landscape material previously planted in this median and all new landscape material shall be consistent with the landscaping theme adopted for this roadway. All landscape material, installation, and maintenance requirements shall be subject to the standards set forth by the Streetscape Standards. If all xeriscape material is utilized, the wate ing of the plant material during the initial heal-in period shall be the responsibility of the property owner. Alternative species other than those listed in the County standards may be allowed subject to approval by the County Engineer. (BLDG PERMIT: MONITORING - Eng)

- b. All required median landscaping, including an irrigation system if required, shall be installed at the property owners expense. All existing landscape material shall also be the perpetual maintenance obligation of the petitioner and its successors, heirs or assignees or duly established Property Owner's Association and/or Homeowners's Association. Perpetual maintenance includes, but is not limited to, pruning, fertilizing, irrigation, and alternate watering of Xeriscape material during periods of drought in order to maintain healthy plant material. All landscape material shall be installed prior to the issuance of a certificate of occupancy. (CO: MONITORING - Eng)
- c. Declaration of Covenants and Restriction Documents evidencinc this obligation shall be established or amended as required and shall be approved and recorded prior to the issuance of a building pe-mit. (BLDG PERMIT: MONITORING Eng)
- F. LANDSCAPING ALONG NORTH PROPERTY LINE (ADJACENT TO ATLANITIC AVENUE)
 - 1. Landscaping and buffering along the north property line shall be upgraded to include:
 - a. A minimum twenty (20) foot wide;
 - b. One (1) native canopy tree planted every twenty (20) feet on center;
 - c. One (1) native palm or pine tree for each thirty (30) linear feet of frontage, with a maximum spacing of sixty (60) feet between clusters;
 - d. A minimum two (2) to three (3) foot high undulating berm, with an average height of two and one half (2½) feet, measured from the top of the curb; and,
 - e. Thirty (30) inch high shrub or hedge material located on the plates u of the berm spaced twenty-four (24) inches on center at installation to be maintained a minimum of sixty (60) inches in height. (SO: LANDSCAPE Zoning)

G. <u>LANDSCAPING ALONG SOUTH PROPERTY LINE</u> (ADJACENT TO LWDD1.-34 CANAL)

- 1. Landscaping and buffering along the south property line shall be upgraded to include:
 - a. A minimum ten (10) foot wide clear buffer with no easement encroachment or reduction permitted;
 - b. One (1) native canopy tree planted every twenty (20) feet on center;
 - c. One (1) native palmor pinetree for each thirty (30) linearfeet of property line, with a maximum spacing of sixty (60) feet between clusters and,
 - d. Thirty (30) inch high shrub or hedge material spaced twenty-four (24) inches on center at installation to be maintained a minimum of seventy-two (72) inches in height. (CO: LANDSCAPE Zoning)

H. <u>LANDSCAPING ALONG EAST PROPERTY LINES</u> (ADJACENTTO MARKLAND LANE AND RESIDENTIAL WITHIN BREEZY ACRES)

- 1. Landscaping and buffering along the east property lines shall be upgraded to include:
 - a. A minimum fifteen (15) foot wide landscape buffer strip;
 - b. One (1) canopy tree planted every twenty (20) feet on center;
 - c. One (1) palm or pine tree for each thirty (30) linear feet of frontage, with a maximum spacing of sixty (60) feet between clusters;
 - d. A minimumone (1) to two (2) foot high undulating berm, with an aver age height of one and one-half (1.5) feet, measured from the top of the curb; and,
 - e. Thirty (30) inch high shrub or hedge material, spaced no more t an twenty four (24) inches on center at installation, to be maintained at a minimum height of sixty (60) inches. (CO: LANDSCAPE Zonin(1)

I. <u>LWDD</u>

1. Prior to plat recordation, the owner shall convey to the District either by Quit Claim or Easement the West 70 feet of the W ½ of the SW ¼ of Sec 14/46,42, less the lands owned by the District, and the South 20 feet of the W ½ of the SW ¼ of the SE ¼ of Section 14/46/42 for the required right-of-way for the E-3 and the L-34 Canals respectively. (PLAT: ENG - LWDD)

J. MASS TRANSIT

- 1. Prior to final certification of the preliminary development plan or site plan by the Development Review Committee, whichever occurs first, the petitioners nall amend the plan to indicate one or more of the following: mass transit access, mass transit shelter(s) and/or a bus stop(s) on or adjacent to the subject property, if required by the Palm Beach County School Board and/or the County Engineer. (DRC: ZONING)
 - Masstransit access, shelters and/or bus stops, if required, shall be constructed by the petitioner in a location and manner acceptable to the Palm BeachCounty School Board, Palm Tran, and County Engineer prior to the issuance of a building permit for the 57th unit. The petitioner shall accommodate the requirement for mass transit access, bus shelters and/or bus stops by dedicating additional right-of-way, if requested by the County Engineer. Provisions for mass transit shall include, at a minimum, a covered sheller, continuous paved pedestrian and bicycle access from the subject property or use to the shelter, appropriate lighting, waste container, and bicycle rack. Eus shelters or bus stops located on private property or in common areas shall be the maintenance responsibility of the property owner. (BLDG PERNIT: MONITORING - Eng)

K. <u>PLANNED UNIT DEVELOPMENT</u>

1. All property included in the legal description of the petition shall be subjec: to a Declaration of Restrictions and Covenants acceptable to the County Attorney's office which shall, among other things, provide for: formation of a single "master" property owner's association, automatic voting membership in the master association by any party holding title to any portion of the subject property, and assessment of all members of the master association for the cost of maintaining all common areas. The property shall not be subjected to the Declaration of Restrictions in phases. Approval of the Declaration must be obtained from the County Attorney's olfice prior to the recordation of the first plat for any portion of the planned development. This Declaration shall be amended when additional units are added to the PUD. (PLAT: ENG - Co Att)

- 2. The 2.06 acre retention easement, described in the Stipulated Order of Taking and Final Judgement (ORB 7887, Page 200) shall not be used for derisity calculation or other uses which are contrary to the Order. (DRC/ONGOING: PLANNING/ZONING - Co Att)
- 3. The PUD will be limited to a maximum of 224 units. (DRC/ONGOING: PLANNING/ZONING Co Att)

L. <u>SCHOOL BOARD</u>

- 1. The petitioner shall post in a clear and visible location in all sales offices and model homes a sign provided by the School Board of Palm Beach County which indicates that school age children in the development may not be assigned to the most proximate public school because of overcrowding, rabial balancing, or other School Board policies. (ONGOING: SCHOOL BOAFCD)
- 2. The subject development shall post a notice of annual boundary school assignments for students from this development. The District will provide an 11"X 17" sign to be posted in a clear and visible location in all sales offices and models. (ONGOING: SCHOOL BOARD)

M. <u>COMPLIANCE</u>

- Ingranting this approval, the Board of County Commissioners relied upon the oral and written representations of the petitioner both on the record and as p art of the application process. Deviations from or violation of these representations shall cause the approval to be presented to the Board of County Commissioners for review under the compliance condition of this approval. (ONGOING: MONITORING - Zoning)
- 2. Failureto comply with any of the conditions of approval for the subject property at any time may result in:
 - a. The issuance of a stop work order; the issuance of a cease and desist order; the denial or revocation of a building permit; the denial or revocation of a Certificate of Occupancy; the denial of any other permit, license or approval to any developer, owner, lessee, or user of the subject property; the revocation of any other permit, license or approval from any developer, owner, lessee, or user of the subject properly; revocation of any concurrency; and/or
 - b. The revocation of the Official Map Amendment, Conditional Use, Requested Use, Development Order Amendment, and/or any other zoning approval; and/or
 - c. A requirement of the development to conform with the standards of the ULDC at the time of the finding of non-compliance, or the addition or modification of conditions reasonably related to the failure to comply with existing conditions; and/or
 - d. Referral to code enforcement; and/or
 - e. Imposition of entitlement density or intensity.

Staff may be directed by the Executive Director of PZ&B or a majority vole of the Code Enforcement Board to schedule a Status Report before the body which approved the Official Zoning Map Amendment, Conditional Use, Requested Use, Development Order Amendment, and/or other zoning approval, in accordance with the provisions of Section 5.8 of the ULDC:, in response any flagrant violation and/or continued violation of anycondition of approval.

Appeals of any departmental administrative actions hereunder may be ta ten to the Palm Beach County Board of Adjustment or as otherwise provided in the Unified Land Development Code (ULDC), as amended. Appeals of any revocation of an Official Zoning MapAmendment, Conditional Use, Requested Use, Development Order Amendment or other actions based on a Board of County Commission decision shall be by petition for writ of certiorari to the Fifteenth Judicial Circuit. (MONITORING)
