## RESOLUTION CORRECTING RESOLUTION R-99-107 <br> RESOLUTIONAPPROVING ZONING PETITION OF CONCORDE INVESTMENTS, INC <br> PETITIONDOA97-027(A)

WHEREAS, Concorde Investments, Inc., petitionedthe Palm Beach County Boardof County Commissioners on January 28, 1999 for an Official Zoning Map Amendment (Rezoning)from Residential Single Family (RS) Zoning Districtto Community Commercial (CC) Zoning District with a COZ; and

WHEREAS, Resolution R-99-107, adoptedon January 28, 1999 confirmingthe action of the Boardof County Commissionersinadvertently contained errors in Conditions A.3, A.4, B.3, B. 5 and 12 of Exhibit C; and

WHEREAS, ConditionsA.3, A.4, B.3, B. 5 and 12 of ExhibitC of Resolution R-99-107 should have read as follows:
A.3. Prior to DRC site plan application, the petitioner shall revise the site plan to relocate the wall ten (10) foot south of the north propertv line pursuant to Section 7.3.F.1.b of the ULDC. (DRC: ZONING)
A.4. Prior to DRC site plan application, the petitioner shall revise the site plan to reflect the relocation of the dumpster. (DRC: ZONING)
B.3. Condition B. 3 of Resolution R-97-973 which currently states:

The maximum height of the building shall be one story and not exceed twenty five (25) feet measured from finished grade to highest point. (BLDG PERMIT: BLDG - Zoning)

Should hereby be amended to state:
The maximum heightof the building shall beone story and not exceed five (25) thirtv-five (35) feet measured from finished grade to highest point. (BLDG PERMIT: BLDG - Zoning)
B.5. Similararchitectural characterandtreatment of the Ekerds store locatedat the northeast corner of Lucerne Avenue and Federat Dixie Highway shall be provided on all sides of this building including rooftreatment. (BLDG PERMIT: BLDG - Zoning)
I.2. The following landscaping requirementsshall be installedon the east side of the required wall:
a. One (1) canopy tree planted every twenty (20) feet on center;
b. One (1) palm or pine tree for each twenty (20) linear feet, with a maximum spacing of sixty (60) feet on center. A group of three or more palm or pine trees may supersedethe requirementfor a canopy tree in that location; and

2. Conditions A.3, A.4, B.3, B.5 and 12 of Exhibit C of Resolution R-99-107 are hereby corrected
