## RESOLUTION CORRECTING RESOLUTION R-99-1153 RESOLUTION APPROVING ZONING PETITION OF IRISHTRADING & INVESTMENTS INC. / MOTIVA ENTERPRISES / FLAGLER REALTY & DEVELOPMENT PETITION DOA89-127(C)

WHEREAS, IRISHTRADING & INVESTMENTS INC./MOTIVA ENTERPRISES/FLAGLER REALTY & DEVELOPMENT, petitioned the Palm Beach County Board of County Commissioners on June 29, 1999 for a Development Order Amendment (DOA) to reconfigure master plan, add buildingsquare footage, modify/delete conditions in resolution R-91-364, and add a second fast food restaurant; and

WHEREAS, Resolution R-99-1153, adopted on June 29,1999 confirming the action of the Board of County Commissioners in advertently contained an error in Condition E.2.a of Exhibit C; and

WHEREAS, Condition E.2.a in Resolution R-99-1153 should have read as follows:

a. Prior to issuance of a building permit, the property owner shall apply to the Palm Beach County Engineering and Public Works Department for a permit to provide for landscape cutouts within the concrete median of Okeechobee Boulevard Rights-of-way contiguous to the site. This permit to be completed by the property owner, shall name Palm Beach County as the applicant. As part of this permit process, the property owner shall enter into a Right of Way Concrete Median Cutout; Landscape and Paver Block Installation Agreement, including appropriate Maintenance, Removal, and Indemnification agreements. When installation of paver blocks and landscape plantings are permitted by the Florida Department of Transportation, the landscape material within the concrete cutouts shall be consistent with the landscaping theme approved by Palm Beach Countyfor this roadway. All landscape material, installation, and maintenance requirements shall be subject to the standards set forth by the Palm Beach County Streetscape Standards. Alternative species and paver block material other than those listed in the County standards may be allowed subject to approval by the County Engineer. (BLDG PERMIT: MONITORING-Eng)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:
