RESOLUTION TO ABANDON THE SPECIAL EXCEPTION GRANTED BY RESOLUTION R-76-0922 APPROVING ZONING PETITION 76-129 (CITY MATTRESS)

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body of Palm Beach County, Florida, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapters 125 and 163, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider petitions related to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Director has determined the request to administratively abandon the special exception granted under R-76-0922, as provided for in Article 5 (Development Review Procedures) of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code (Ordinance 92-20, as amended), meets the requirements contained therein; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Directorhas administratively abandoned the special exception granted under R-76-0922, as provided for in Article 5 (Development Review Procedures) of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code (Ordinance 92-20, as amended); and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Directorpresented the abandonment of the special exception granted under Resolution R-76-0922 to the Board of County Commissioners for ratification on December 2, 1999; and

WHEREAS, Article 5, Section 5.3.D.9 (Action by Board of County Commissioners) of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code requires that action of the Board of County Commissioners be adopted by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that the Special Exception granted under Resolution R-76-0922, approving Zoning Petition 76-129, the petition of Roger Schintzius, by William Boose, agent, for a special exception to allow an auto service station, automatic car wash and office/warehouse combination is hereby abandoned.
