## **RESOLUTION NO. R-2006-0004**

## RESOLUTION REVOKING RESOLUTIONS R-1990-586 AND R-2004-0005 (CONTROL NUMBER 1989-069) AFFIRMING THE ADMINISTRATIVE ABANDONMENT OF ZONING APPLICATIONS SE1989-069 AND SR1989-069.9

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body of Palm Beach County, Florida, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapters 125 and 163, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider applications related to zoning; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Director has administratively abandoned the development order, as provided for in Article 2 (Development Review Procedures) of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code (Ordinance 2003-067) and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Director presented the abandonment of the development order to the Board of County Commissioners for ratification on January 5, 2006; and

WHEREAS, Article 2.A.1.K (Public Hearing Procedures) of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code requires that action of the Board of County Commissioners be adopted by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Resolution R-1998-586, approving Zoning Application SE1989-069, the petition of Grace Roma, by Dennis P. Koehler, agent, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION to PERMIT A PLANNED OFFICE BUSINESS PARK; and that Resolution R-2004-005 approving Zoning Application SR1989-069.9, a Status Report to amend conditions of approval are hereby revoked.
