RESOLUTION CORRECTING RESOLUTION NO. R-2004-0720 WHICH APPROVED RECOMMENDATION OF STATUS REPORT CR 2002-027/E10 TO APPROVE A DEVELOPMENT ORDER AMENDMENT TO AMEND CONDITIONS OF APPROVAL OF RESOLUTION NO. R-2003-0103 FOR THE PREVIOUS PETITION OF LANCE UHLEY, TRUSTEE PETITION NO. 2002-027

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners on April 22, 2004, conducted a public hearing for Status Report CR 2002-027/E10; and

WHEREAS, Resolution NO. R-2004-0720 adopted on April 22, 2004, inadvertently contained an error in condition number 2; and

WHEREAS, condition number 2 of Resolution NO. R-2004-0720 should have read as follows:

Condition No. E.2. of Resolution No. R-2003-103 which currently states:

In order to comply with the mandatory Traffic Performance Standards, the Developer shall be restricted to the following phasing schedule:

- a.) Building permits shall not be issued for more than 3493 square feet of convenience store, a 12-fueling position gas station, 2143 square feet of fast food restaurant, 2200 square feet of retail, 114345 square feet of self-storage, 1 caretakers unit, 0.3 acres of outdoor storage, a 3-bay oil change facility, a 1-bay automatic car wash, and a 7710 square feet tire store until construction has commenced for the 4-lane widening of Lyons Road from Lantana Road to Hypoluxo Road. (BLDG PERMIT: MONITORING-Eng)
- b) The developer shall provide an approved phasing plan prior to DRC approval outlining how the site will comply with the phasing condition "a" above. (DRC APPROVAL: ENG)
- c) No Building Permits for the site may be issued after December 31, 2004. A time extension for this condition may be approved by the County Engineer based upon an approved Traffic Study, which complies with Mandatory Traffic Performance Standards in place at the time of the request. This extension request shall be made pursuant to the requirements of Section 5.8 of the Unified Land Development Code. (DATE: MONITORING-Eng)

Acceptable surety required for the Lyons Road widening improvements as outlined in the Condition above shall be posted with the Office of the Land Development Division on or before July 23, 2003. Surety in the amount of 110% shall be based upon a Certified Cost Estimate provided by the Developer's Engineer. (TPS - Maximum 6 month time extension) (DATE: MONITORING-Eng)

Is hereby amended to state:

In order to comply with the mandatory Traffic Performance Standards, the Developer shall be restricted to the following phasing schedule:

a.) Building permits shall not be issued for more than 3493 square feet of convenience store, a 12-fueling position gas station, 2143 square feet of fast food restaurant, 2200 square feet of retail, 114345 square feet of self-storage,

1 caretakers unit, 0.3 acres of outdoor storage, a 3-bay oil change facility, a 1-bay automatic car wash, and a 7710 square feet tire store until construction has commenced for the 4-lane widening of Lyons Road from Lantana Road to Hypoluxo Road. (BLDG PERMIT: MONITORING-Eng)

- The developer shall provide an approved phasing plan prior to DRC approval b) outlining how the site will comply with the phasing condition "a" above. (DRC APPROVAL: ENG)
- No Building Permits for the site may be issued after December 31, 2004. A c) time extension for this condition may be approved by the County Engineer based upon an approved Traffic Study, which complies with Mandatory Traffic Performance Standards in place at the time of the request. This extension request shall be made pursuant to the requirements of Section 5.8 of the Unified Land Development Code. (DATE: MONITORING-Eng)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:
