## RESOLUTION REVOKING RESOLUTION R-1976-823 (CONTROL NUMBER 1976-114) AFFIRMING THE ADMINISTRATIVE ABANDONMENT OF ZONING APPLICATION SE1976-114

WHEREAS, Article 2.A.1.K (Public Hearing Procedures) of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code requires that action of the Board of County Commissioners be adopted by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Resolution R-1976-823, approving Zoning Application SE1976-114, the petition of James K. Schaefer, for a SPECIAL EXCEPTION to allow a CAR RENTAL, AUTO REPAIR AND AUTO PAINT AND BODY SHOP is hereby revoked.
