

RESOLUTION NO. R-2008- 1144

RESOLUTION REVOKING RESOLUTIONS R-2006-029 and R-2006-030
(CONTROL NO. 2005-00394)
AFFIRMING THE ADMINISTRATIVE ABANDONMENT
OF ZONING APPLICATIONS R/W-2005-1174

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, as the governing body of Palm Beach County, Florida, pursuant to the authority vested in Chapters 125 and 163, Florida Statutes, is authorized and empowered to consider applications related to zoning; and

WHEREAS, Zoning Application R/W-2005-1174 were presented to the Board of County Commissioners at a public hearing conducted on January 5, 2006; and

WHEREAS, Resolutions R-2006-029 and R-2006-030 approving these applications were adopted by the Board of County Commissioners on January 5, 2006; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Director has determined the request to administratively abandon the development order, as provided for in Article 2 (Development Review Process) of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code (Ordinance 2003-067, as amended) meets the requirements contained therein; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Director presented the abandonment of the development order to the Board of County Commissioners for ratification on June 30, 2008; and

WHEREAS, Article 2.A.1.K.3.b (Action by BCC) of the Palm Beach County Unified Land Development Code requires that action of the Board of County Commissioners be adopted by resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, that Resolutions R-2006-029 and R-2006-030, approving Zoning Application R/W-2005-1174, the application of Palm Beach Aggregates Inc, for a Requested Use granted under Resolution R-2006-029 and the Waiver of Objectives and Standards granted under Resolution R-2006-030 are hereby revoked.

Commissioner Aaronson moved for the approval of the Resolution.

THAT PART OF THE SOUTH 360 FEET OF SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 43 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA; LESS THE NORTH 240 FEET OF THE SOUTH 360 FEET OF SAID SECTION 21; ALSO THE NORTH 50 FEET OF THE SOUTH 120 FEET OF THE EAST 220 FEET OF SAID SECTION 21.

ALL OF SECTION 28, TOWNSHIP 43 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA.

ALL OF SECTION 33, TOWNSHIP 43 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, LYING NORTH OF STATE ROAD 80 RIGHT-OF-WAY.

ALSO TOGETHER WITH:

PARCEL 9:

THAT PART OF THE WEST 780 FEET OF SECTION 34, TOWNSHIP 43 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST, PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, LYING NORTH OF STATE ROAD 80 RIGHT-OF-WAY.

LESS AND EXCEPTING FROM PARCELS 2, 5 AND 8, THAT PORTION WHICH LIES WITHIN THAT STRIP OF LAND WHICH LIES 46.00 FEET EAST OF, AS MEASURED AT RIGHT ANGLES TO, THE EASTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF THE SOUTH FLORIDA WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT L-8 CANAL AS PER THE RIGHT-OF-WAY MAP FOR SAID L-8 CANAL, DWG "L-8-1", AND DATED MAY 8, 1950, AND PROVIDED TO THIS OFFICE BY THE SOUTH FLORIDA WATER MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT OF SURVEY.
