

ZONING RESOLUTION #3-E-60
MODIFYING THE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES
ADOPTED FEBRUARY 4, 1960

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ZONING COMMISSION OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled this the 4th day of February, A. D. 1960, that the following modification of District Boundaries is hereby adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution #3 pursuant to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of Florida 1959:

The action of the Palm Beach County Zoning Commission at their regular meeting of October 2, 1959 whereby they rezoned the two hundred fifty foot (250') strips of C-1A Limited Commercial Districts on either side of Military Trail (State Road 809) from Gun Club Road, south to a point one hundred fifty feet (150') north of 10th Avenue, to C-1 Neighborhood Commercial District subject to the property owners providing the County with the additional right-of-way needed for the ultimate right-of-way of Military Trail, as recorded in the Zoning Commission Minute Book 3, at Page 617, is hereby rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the two parcels on which the additional right-of-way for Military Trail was provided between October 2, 1959 and this date are excluded from this rescission.
