

ZONING RESOLUTION #3-M-67

MODIFYING THE REGULATIONS  
GOVERNING TEMPORARY STORAGE AREAS  
FOR JUNK CARS AND APPLIANCES

ADOPTED JUNE 1, 1967

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ZONING COMMISSION OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled this the 1st day of June, A. D. 1967, that the following is hereby adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution #3 pursuant to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 57-1691, Special Laws of Florida 1957, and Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of Florida 1959:

Add to SECTION 14, the following Paragraph 21:

21. Temporary Storage Areas for Junk Cars and Appliances

For the purpose of cleaning up abandoned cars and appliances in the county, it is necessary to have a storage area for junk for periods of time for up to sixty days.

In order to do this, any area in the county selected by the County Engineer and approved by the Director of Planning, Zoning and Building may be so based, if prior to the use, there is filed with the Zoning Director notification of the legal description of the area indicating the period of time it is to be used for the storage area for the abandoned cars and appliances, and written consent of the owner of the property. The said property must be put back in clean condition, satisfactory to the Zoning Department and the owner. If these requirements are met, no other provision of this Resolution shall apply.
