

ZONING RESOLUTION #3-P-66

MODIFYING THE REGULATIONS
GOVERNING THE PAVING OF
OFFSTREET PARKING SPACES

ADOPTED AUGUST 4, 1966

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ZONING COMMISSION OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled this the 4th day of August, A. D. 1966, that the following is hereby adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution #3 pursuant to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 57-1691, Special Laws of Florida 1957, and Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of Florida 1959:

Add the Following at the End of Section 12-1:

Offstreet parking facilities, including access drives and aisles shall be surfaced with a hard dustless material consisting of a good-rolled rock base, well tamped and topped with oil and sand or asphalt or of concrete of sufficient thickness to accommodate the proposed vehicular weights. The parking area shall be marked, either by painted lines, precast curbs or in a similar equal fashion to indicate the individual parking spaces. All required offstreet parking facilities shall be drained so as not to cause any nuisance to adjacent private or public property.

A Certificate of Occupancy for the given structure or premises shall be prohibited until the required parking area has been improved, inspected and approved.
