

ZONING RESOLUTION #3-Q-66
MODIFYING THE DISTRICT BOUNDARIES
ADOPTED SEPTEMBER 1, 1966

WHEREAS, on the 1st day of April, 1965, the Zoning Commission conditionally approved certain zoning changes hereinafter set forth, and the conditions have been met as of the 27th day of May, 1966:

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ZONING COMMISSION OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA, in regular session assembled the 1st day of September, 1966, that the following modification of District Boundaries is hereby adopted as an Amendment to Zoning Resolution #3 pursuant to the authority vested in said Commission by Chapter 57-1691, Special Laws of Florida 1957, and Chapter 59-1686, Special Laws of Florida 1959:

The North four hundred feet (N 400') of the South four hundred and fifty three feet (S 453') of the East one quarter (E 1/4) of the Northwest one-quarter (NW 1/4) of the Southeast one quarter (SE 1/4) and the North four hundred feet (N 400') of the South four hundred and fifty three feet (S 453') of the West seventy feet (W 70') of the Northeast one quarter (NE 1/4) of the Southeast one-quarter (SE 1/4) of Section 13, Township 46 South, Range 42 East is hereby rezoned from A-1 Agricultural District to C-1A Limited Commercial District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all actions of the Director of Planning, Zoning and Building recognizing the change since the date the aforesaid conditions were met, are hereby ratified and approved.
