

ZONING RESOLUTION NO. 5-A-57

AMENDING THE GUIDE FOR THE ASSISTANCE OF BUILDERS DOING
CONVENTIONAL CONSTRUCTION UP TO TWENTY-FIVE FEET IN
HEIGHT IN PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA

AUGUST 2, 1957

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ZONING COMMISSION OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA,
IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, THIS THE 2nd DAY OF August, A. D. 1957,
THAT THE GUIDE FOR THE ASSISTANCE OF BUILDERS DOING CONVENTIONAL CONSTRUCTION UP
TO TWENTY-FIVE FEET IN HEIGHT IN PALM BEACH COUNTY, AS ADOPTED MAY 13, 1957, BY
ZONING RESOLUTION NO. 5 IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

Add the following after SECTION 106.2

107.2 - FAILURE TO OBTAIN A PERMIT

If any person commences any work on a building or structure before obtain-
ing the necessary permit from the Zoning Director, the fee for the permit when
obtained shall be double the amount set forth in SECTION 107.4 - SCHEDULE OF PERMIT
FEES.

107.4 - SCHEDULE OF PERMIT FEES

Add the following after SECTION 107.4 (f):

(g) Tax supported public agencies desiring to do work in the County that
comes within the purview of this code shall obtain permit for same, and shall perform
the work in full compliance with this code; however, when the work is to be done by
the regularly employed workmen of said public agencies, no permit fee shall be charged,
and the workmen shall not be required to have a license in order to do the work.

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that no other provisions of the Guide for the Assistance
of Builders Doing Conventional Construction up to Twenty-Five Feet in Height in Palm
Beach County are waived or changed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution (less the Southern
Standard Building Code 1953-1954 Revision) be furnished hereafter to all persons upon
their request and the payment of a fee to be set by the Zoning Director.
