

AMENDING THE GUIDE FOR THE ASSISTANCE OF BUILDERS DOING  
CONVENTIONAL CONSTRUCTION UP TO TWENTY-FIVE FEET IN  
HEIGHT IN PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ZONING COMMISSION OF PALM BEACH COUNTY, FLORIDA,  
IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, THIS THE 6th DAY OF September  
A. D. 1957, THAT THE GUIDE FOR THE ASSISTANCE OF BUILDERS DOING CON-  
VENTIONAL CONSTRUCTION UP TO TWENTY-FIVE FEET IN HEIGHT IN PALM BEACH  
COUNTY, FLORIDA, AS ADOPTED MAY 13, 1957, BY ZONING RESOLUTION NO. 5,  
IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

107.4 - SCHEDULE OF PERMIT FEES

Delete SECTION 107.4(d) and substitute the following:

(d) Erection of Signs

1. For signs the fee shall be the same as outlined in SECTION 107.4(a)  
above.

706.8 - DETAILS OF ROOF COVERING

Delete SECTION 706.8H6 and substitute the following:

6. Corrugated asbestos cement, galvanized sheets, corrugated iron sheets,  
galvanized iron sheets, or other materials or products which ~~in the opinion of the Zoning~~  
~~Director~~ are similar in general appearance at distances of 50 to 200 feet, shall not be  
used for siding or roofing visible from the ground, except in the Industrial Districts;  
provided however that this restriction shall not apply to farm structures such as barns,  
sheds and the like in the A-1 District, and shall not apply to structures in any Dis-  
trict that are designed by an architect ~~whose principal place of business is in Palm~~  
~~Beach County.~~

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED that no other provisions of the Guide for the Assistance of Builders  
doing Conventional Construction up to Twenty-Five Feet in Height are waived or changed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be furnished hereafter to all per-  
sons upon their request and the payment of a fee to be set by the Zoning Director.
