Find the light blue banner and click on the "FLOOD ZONE MAPS" icon



This will bring you to Palm Beach County's (PBC's) new FEMA FLOOD ZONE LOOKUP site


The site will navigate to an address if it is input into the "Search Address" input box. First White Arrow in next figure.

Once a parcel is selected a dialog box with both the 2017 and 2024 FIRM information will open.



A user can see a list of the available layers and turn them on or off by clicking on the "layers" icon.



Layer that are turn of have the "eye" icon with no "slash" Each layer can be turn On or Off by clicking on it.

The legend can be restored by clicking on the "bullets" icon The FEMA PENDING 2024 layer is the Coastal FIRMs that will go into effect on December 20, 2024.



If you are looking for a Zone or Base Flood Elevation (BFE) I strongly recommend that you only have one FEMA FIRM layer on at a time.

Once you find you location I recommend turning the Municipalities layer off.
