## Parental Accommodation and Youth Anxiety

Anxiety disorders are among the most common mental health disorders for youth in the United States, impeding functioning in school, socializing with friends, and spending time with family. Parents often respond using parental accommodating behaviors, such as distraction or changing daily routines, to decrease their youth's anxiety. Although well-intentioned, parental accommodating behaviors inadvertently maintain youth anxiety by reinforcing avoidance coping and decreasing self-reliance. This presentation will define parental accommodation, explore its relationship with youth anxiety, and offer alternative parenting strategies.
